

# Effective 19 August 2004

## Notice from the United States Bankruptcy Court, District of Nebraska:

At the request of several ECF users, we have researched the capability to modify the subject line in email messages received from our ECF system. Therefore, please note that effective August 19, 2004, the subject line on e-mail messages you receive from our ECF system will be slightly altered. We are confident that the alterations will make it easier for the ECF users to see, at a glance, the most useful case information without immediately opening the email message.

The current subject line for bankruptcy cases is CaseNumber and Pleading filed. The new subject line on bankruptcy cases will be:

Ch # CaseNumber CaseName "pleading filed"  
(ie: Ch 7 02-80002 Jimmy Sanderson "Administrative Resolution")

Adversaries now appear as CaseNumber and Pleading filed. The new subject line on adversary cases will be:

Ch CaseNumber CaseName "pleading filed"  
(ie: Ch 02-08001 Smith et al v. Smith "Motion to Compel").

**PLEASE NOTE: There will be NO chapter designation on an adversary case. Only the word "Ch" will appear, followed by the case number.**

If you receive an email summary from our ECF system (all email messages once day), there will be NO change to the subject line of those messages. The alterations made are more specific to those ECF Users receiving each email message individually so they can utilize their email software Rules for easier processing.

We hope this message will provide you with ample time to make the changes necessary to rules, etc., in your electronic email system.
