

PACER: Public Access to Court Electronic Records. Consistent with congressional requirements, access to view full case information, including the docket and all filed documents is available via the Internet through the federal court's Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER) system at <https://ecf.neb.uscourts.gov/cgi-bin/login.pl>. Registration for new users, billing, and technical support can be obtained from the PACER Service Center's website at <http://pacer.psc.uscourts.gov/>. PACER fees are \$.07 per page with a maximum of \$2.10, the equivalent of 30 pages, for electronic access to any single document (Note: attachments are treated as separate documents). CM/ECF registered attorneys will be able to obtain one free electronic copy of the documents in his/her own case.

A traditional dial up system which displays case information and docket sheets is available by calling (800) 788-0656 or (402) 661-7450. A computer with a modem is required to access the system and an account needs to be established with the PACER Service Center.

VCIS: Voice Case Information System. (800) 829-0112 or (402) 661-7457. By entering a name, this system allows access to basic case information using your telephone for assistance in determining a case number, general information regarding a case, or status of a case filed after September 1, 1989. This service is free and is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, except for those periods when system maintenance is required (general down time is daily between the hours of 6:30 - 7:30 a.m.).
