

Mr. Rosberg did not file a designation of the record and a statement of issues to be heard on appeal within ten days from the date he filed his appeal as required by Bankruptcy Rule of Procedure 8006, and did so only after a show cause order was issued against him. Once the record on appeal was finally transmitted to this Court, he was allowed additional time to file a brief in support of his appeal. He has now failed to file a brief in support of his appeal within the allowed extension of time, and has gone beyond all bounds of diligence in prosecuting his appeal. Therefore, this matter will be dismissed pursuant to Local Rule 22.


In view of the foregoing action, the Court finds appellant's request for injunction should be denied as moot. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1) This appeal is dismissed for lack of diligent prosecution pursuant to Local Rule 22.
- 2) Appellant's request for injunction is denied.
