

This matter is before the Court upon the plaintiff's request (filing 13) for an entry of default against certain defendants who have not answered plaintiff's amended complaint (filing 9). One year ago, upon the suggestion in bankruptcy filed by defendant James Stinehagen (filing 5), the Court referred this case to the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Nebraska. Plaintiff has not indicated the status of the bankruptcy proceeding, e.g., whether the automatic stay is still in effect.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The referral of this case to the Bankruptcy Court is hereby reaffirmed, and all motions, pleadings and other materials shall be addressed in the first instance to the Bankruptcy Judge. See section 157(c)(1) of the Bankruptcy Amendments and Federal Judgeship Act of 1984.

2. The request for an entry of default is denied, without prejudice to its reassertion in compliance with this Order.
