This General Order, effective January 19, 2022, amends Appendix "I" to the Nebraska Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure adopted on December 17, 2018.



Effective January 19, 2022, all Certificates of Service must be substantially in the form set forth in Revised Appendix "I". *See attached.*


