## SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM

This memorandum supplements my remarks made in open court at the conclusion of the trial on the application for adequate protection filed by Saline State Bank.

In those remarks I indicated that the order would require the providing of value of \$137.10 to the date of the giving of value of \$31,395.90. The order actually provides for the giving of value of \$137.10 indefinitely. I see no reason to limit the award of adequate protection to the past. The erosion will continue, presumably, into the future and the provision for value as adequate protection should, in my view, continue into the future. The form of that value may be in the discretion of the trustee and may be in the value of cash payments, a lien on other property or the appreciation of the subject real estate in value.
